7v7 Tournament Rules

All games shall be in accordance with the FIFA "Laws Of The Game", except as modified below:

FIELD OF PLAY

- Field shall be a minimum of 40 yards wide by 50 yards long; penalty area shall extend 12 yards from the closest goal post, and goals shall be at least 18 feet wide by 6 feet tall.

PLAYERS, SCORING, AND EQUIPMENT

- Teams will consist of minimum of 7 players and maximum of 13, one of whom is the goalkeeper. A match may not start or continue if either team consists of fewer than 5 players. Changes may be made to the roster prior to the start of the first game and thereafter cannot be changed. Teams having an ineligible player will be required to FORFEIT that match.
- **PHOTO ID OR BIRTH CERTIFICATES ARE REQUIRED FOR U-19, OVER-30, AND OTHER NON-OPEN DIVISIONS**
- **FOR PREMIER/JACKPOT DIVISIONS: Only those players that are present, listed, and signed on the roster before the 1st game may play in the tournament. NO EXCEPTIONS!! Each team shall be present at the field before each game at least 20 minutes before game time to verify the roster. If a team is found to have ineligible players, that team will automatically be disqualified from the tournament, forfeit their remaining matches, and become ineligible for the Jackpot.**
- **GOALS MAY ONLY BE SCORED FROM THE ATTACKING HALF OF THE FIELD.** Play will resume with a GOAL KICK on the side of the field that the ball crossed the goal line.
- In Co-ed matches, at least 3 FEMALE PLAYERS must be on the field at all times, not including the goal keeper. Goals made by females are worth 2 goals.
 - If a team has fewer than 3 female players, then that team must reduce the number of male players on the field to the number of female players, excluding the goal keeper.
 - During play, a penalty kick made by a female is worth 2 goals if the foul was committed on that female.
 - During overtime, a maximum of three females may take penalty kicks.
- Teams shall wear uniforms of matching design and color, and should have numbers. In the event of a conflict in uniform color, the home team shall be required to change.
- The goalkeeper must wear a distinctly different color from both teams and the referee.

SUBSTITUTIONS—Teams may have unlimited substitutions. Substitutions may be made at any stoppage of play with the permission of the referee.

REFEREES—Each preliminary game will have at least one referee. Semi-finals and final games may have additional referees. All decisions by the referee(s) are final.

DURATION OF MATCH

- Games will be two 25-minute halves (running clock) with a 5-minute half-time interval.
- Overtime:
 - There will be no Overtime periods in preliminary matches.
 - Quarterfinal, semi-final and final matches will have one 5 minute overtime period. If the match is still tied, then a 5 minute "Golden Goal" overtime period will be played. If there still is no score, then Penalty Kicks will follow.
- The Tournament Director reserves the right to shorten game lengths.

START AND RESTART OF PLAY

- Restarts from the sidelines shall be with either a throw-in or kick-in from the point nearest where the ball crossed the sideline. A goal cannot be scored directly from a throw-in or kick-in.
- Goal kicks shall be taken from anywhere inside the penalty area.
- Goals may be scored directly on corner kicks.

FOULS & FREE KICKS

- **ALL DIRECT AND INDIRECT FOULS APPLY, except as modified by these rules.**

- **NO SLIDING TACKLING WHAT SO EVER!!** An indirect kick shall be awarded from the point of the infraction.
- Opposing players must be at least 6 yards from the ball for all free kicks and kick-ins.
- An indirect free kick shall be awarded from the point closest to the infraction on the midfield line if: (i) a goal kick is kicked directly across midfield without the ball first touching a player or hitting the ground; or (ii) a goalkeeper throws, punts, or drop-kicks the ball across midfield without the ball first touching a player or hitting the ground.
- **A player that is a cautioned MUST leave the field of play and may be substituted for.**
- A player, substitute or substituted player who has been sent off and shown the red card must leave the vicinity of the field of play.
- **FIGHTING WILL ABSOLUTELY NOT BE TOLORATED. ANY PERSON SENT OFF FOR FIGHTING WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PLAY FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE TOURNAMENT AND SHALL BE REQUIRED TO LEAVE THE FIELD/COMPLEX. NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- **USING OFFENSIVE, OR INSULTING OR ABUSIVE LANGUAGE AND/OR GESTURES WILL NOT BE TOLERATED AND WILL RESULT IN DISCIPLINARY ACTION.**
- **The Tournament Director shall determine the length of suspension for a player that has been sent off. A player sent off during a match shall not be eligible to compete in future tournament matches UNLESS the player pays a \$25 fine to the Tournament Director.**

INCLEMENT WEATHER—Regardless of weather conditions coaches and their teams must appear on the field of play, ready to play as scheduled. Failure to play will result in the forfeit of the match. Only referees and/or Tournament Director may cancel or postpone a match. Should a match's progress be terminated due to weather conditions after one half has been completed the match will be considered official and the score at the time will stand.

DETERMINATION OF WINNERS

- **Group Play**—In group play, there will be no overtime games. Standings in a group will be determined by:
 - WIN = 3 pts TIE = 1 pts LOSS = 0 pts
- **TIEBREAKERS** (in the following order)
 - Head-to-head competition
 - Goal differential (Maximum 5 goals for, no max for goals against)
 - Least goals against
 - Most goals scored (Maximum 5 goals)
 - Penalty Kicks.

Note: If more there are more than 2 teams tied, the following order shall be used until the number of teams is reduced. Then, the procedure shall be repeated for the remaining teams.

FORFEITS— Games should start at the given time. In case a team does not have 5 players present, it should be allowed a maximum of 10 minutes grace period before declaring a forfeit. A forfeit will be scored with the winning team getting all points for the win and the maximum goal differential for that match.

TERMINATED GAMES—Any game terminated for other than inclement weather will not be replayed. The decision as to the score of the game and whether the teams advance will be made by the Tournament Director.

PROTEST—No protests will be allowed

THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR HAS THE FINAL AUTHORITY IN ALL ASPECTS OF THE TOURNAMENT. SITUATIONS OR OCCURRENCES THAT THESE RULES DO NOT ADDRESS SHALL BE LEFT TO THE SOLE DISCRETION OF TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR. ALL DECISIONS MADE BY THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR ARE FINAL.
